Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and Income • Credit History and Purchase History • Transaction History and Employment History
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Nix Check Cashing chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Nix Check Cashing protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Nix Check Cashing collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • open an account or provide employment information • give us your contact information or show your government issued ID • pay your bills We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our affiliates include:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Companies with Kinecta in the name</i> • <i>Financial Companies such as: Kinecta Financial & Insurance Services, Kinecta Financial Management Company</i> • <i>Non-financial companies such as Apollo Insurance Services</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Nix Check Cashing does not share with non-affiliated third parties so they can market to you</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Nix Check Cashing does not engage in joint marketing.</i>
Other important information	
State laws may give you additional rights to limit non-affiliate sharing. For residents of Alaska, California, Florida, Illinois, Maine, Maryland, North Dakota and Vermont, the information that you provide to us will not be shared with non-affiliated third parties, except as required or permitted by law, unless you contact Nix and request your information be shared with non-affiliated third parties.
